The Groveton Trailblazer's snowmobile club will no longer be holding the annual OHRV safety course due to there being no demand.

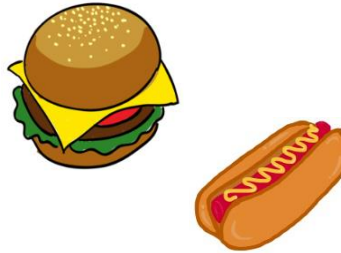
Over the past two years, the State of NH has gone to an on-line training program and due to this, there has not been the demand at the local level to hold these events.
